## **Year 7 Scholarships**

In 2026 scholarships will be offered in the following areas:

- Achieving Curriculum Excellence (ACE) Academic Program: The ACE Program has been established to cater for students aspiring to reach high academic standards with the ultimate aim of successful university graduation. The student selected for an ACE Scholarship will be expected to extend themselves; take on added responsibilities; and positively contribute to the everyday life of Swan View Senior School. Hiah
- Future Artists Mastering Expression (FAME) Academy Specialist Drama **Program:** The Swan View Specialised Drama Program is a Department of Education specialist program for students who show particular talent and interest drama and related in careers.
- Elite Basketball: The Basketball program is a timetabled elective that helps students develop skills, game understanding, and tactical knowledge. It includes individual coaching, fitness training, testing, and a junior referee course. Students will participate in day competitions and excursions while building teamwork and leadership skills essential for higher-level play.
- Citizenship: The student selected for a Citizenship Scholarship will be expected to demonstrate leadership potential and take on other added responsibilities. They will adhere to the school values 'DARE' Diligent, Accountable, Respectful, Extraordinary; and positively contribute to the everyday life of Swan View Senior High School.

The scholarships are for one year and cover the costs of all school contributions and charges to the value of \$300.

## **Specialist and School-Based Programs**

The following Department of Education endorsed specialist program will be offered at Swan View Senior High School:



### **Future Artists Mastering Expression (FAME)** Academy - Specialist Drama Program

Students are provided with the opportunity to extend their skills in acting and production areas and exposes students to a wide range of theatre experiences. Over the course of four years, students participate in workshops with industry professionals, training them in basic circus skills, stage combat, special effects makeup, use of technology to edit and create sound for their stage production, and other acting and production skills.

To gain entry into the FAME Academy students will need to successfully complete the audition process, details will be communicated via your child's Primary School.

# Achieving Curriculum Excellence (ACE) The ACE program at Swan View Senior High School is for

ROGRAM students who aspire to go to university. It focuses on academic excellence and extension and targets students aspiring to an ATAR pathway in Years 11 and 12. ACE offers a wide range of academic enrichment opportunities and students are expected to demonstrate exemplary attitude, behaviour and effort.

The ACE Student program is offered to those students in Year 6 who have been identified by the ACE Coordinator and their primary school teachers as suitable candidates for the secondary ACE program. These students will have achieved high scores in NAPLAN testing and consistently demonstrated academic aptitude in the classroom, including excellent standards of attitude, behaviour and effort.

#### Elite Basketball

The Basketball program gives students in Years 7-10 the chance to pursue their passion for Basketball and aims to develop skills, game understanding and tactical knowledge. This class is offered as a timetabled elective and allows the opportunity for students to be involved in day competitions and excursions.

The program provides students with individual fundamental coaching combined with fitness training, testing and completion of a junior referee course. Students will have the ability to demonstrate and develop strong teamwork and leadership skills which are essential for higher level and elite competition.

Students will be held to behaviour and engagement standards to remain in the programs.

To be eligible for the program students must attend try-outs, details will be communicated via your child's Primary School.



#### **Soccer Academy**

Soccer Academy runs two periods each week in Years 87-10. plus additional opportunities for training, competitions and excursions outside of class time. It gives students the chance to pursue their passion for Soccer. Students will develop skills, fitness, game understanding and tactical knowledge. The Academy provides students with quality coaching to assist them in reaching their potential as well as opportunities to prepare for competition outside of school.

To be eligible for the program students must attend try-outs, details will be communicated via your child's Primary School.
